

**PLUMBING 'RESIDENTIAL' FEE SCHEDULE**  
(situations other than the basics described on the Permit Fee Schedule page)

**HUD or MRC HOME**

HUD\* home (single or double-wide) on piers – located on *private property* or in a *mobile home park*:

Fee = \$63 (covers the inspection for water and sewer connections)

HUD double-wide home on basement (finished or unfinished) with underground: Fee = \$206

HUD double-wide home on basement (finished or unfinished) without underground: Fee = \$ 63

MRC\* home on crawlspace with underground: Fee = \$206

MRC home on crawlspace without underground: Fee = \$144

MRC home on basement with underground: Fee = \$206

MRC home on basement without underground: Fee = \$144

\*Housing & Urban Development (Federal)  
Michigan Residential Code (State)

**DETACHED GARAGE / POLE BUILDING\*\***

Unfinished with water: Fee = \$ 63

Finished with water: Fee = \$ 63  
unless any thing is concealed, then - Fee = \$144

Includes a bathroom with underground: Fee = \$206

[\*\*Note: a detached building, i.e., pole building, garage, etc., must have a separate plumbing permit even if it is being constructed at the same time as the house. The 'new residence' fee applies only to the house.]

**SWIMMING POOL**

No plumbing inspections required

**MISCELLANEOUS SINGLE INSPECTIONS**

Water heater – exchange-out (gas to gas or electric to electric): (Note: a mechanical permit could be used in lieu of plumbing, but plumbing is the preferred permit for this situation)	Fee = \$63
Water heater (changing from gas to electric): (Note: electrical permit is also required @ \$63)	Fee = \$63
Water heater (changing from electric to gas): (Note: mechanical permit is also required @ \$63)	Fee = \$63
Status inspection:	Fee = \$63
