Ionia County, Michigan

Sebewa Township only:

OPERATION MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the expired previous voted increases in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Sebewa Township, of 2 Mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 1.9192 Mills (\$1.92 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 2 Mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for two years, 2010 through 2011 inclusive for the purpose of providing additional funds for graveling, other maintenance and construction of local roads of Sebewa Township raising an estimated \$70,956.00 in the first year the millage is levied.

Lyons Township only:

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT

Shall the previous voted increase in the constitutional tax rate limitation on the amount of taxes imposed upon all property within the Township of Lyons, Ionia County, Michigan, be renewed in the amount of 0.5 mills on each dollar (\$.50 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of twenty (20) years, 2010 to 2029, both inclusive, to provide funds for fire department operating expenses (such renewal is estimated to provide revenues of approximately \$35,700 in the first year of the levy and includes a renewal of previously authorized millage in the amount of 0.4288 mills (\$0.4228 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) and a new additional millage of 0.0772 mills (\$0.0772 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) to restore millage lost as a result of the "Headlee" restoration)?

Odessa Township only:

OPERATION MILLAGE – ROADS

Shall Odessa Township impose an increase of up to 1.000 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 4 years, 2010 through 2013 inclusive, for road maintenance which includes gravel, brine and culverts of township roads, which 1.000 mill increase will raise an estimated \$100,996.00 in the first year the millage is levied of which a portion will be disbursed to the Lake Odessa Downtown Development Authority.
