

## Coordinator's Update APRIL

### Events and News:

Enforcement zones took place in February in Belding and Ionia. Belding police reported 31 vehicles stopped during the enforcement zone shift for the month of February. There was 1 OWI issued, 1 suspended license, 1 red light running, and 5 other traffic violations. Ionia reported 17 vehicles stopped; 1 registration violation, 6 speed violations, 7 equipment violations, and 2 traffic control device violations.

Teen Intervene continues through ICHD. The next class is April 19, 2010. The program has been completed by 10 participants, started but not completed by 5 participants, and three more are signed up but have not yet begun the class.
