Members of The Ionia County Sheriff Office were sent to the area of Nash Hwy and Gould Rd for the report of several gun shots being fired with the sound of someone screaming. Through their investigation they came into contact with a 28 year old Saranac man who admitted to being intoxicated when he was discharging a handgun, which was later found to be stolen. For this, he was arrested on receiving and concealing the stolen handgun and the wreckless discharge of the firearm. Further investigation into the stolen property led Deputies to conduct further searches that uncovered an Estimated 15 to 20 thousand dollars worth of stolen property. The stolen property included Firearms, tools and farm tractors.

Assisting the Sheriff Office with this investigation was the Michigan State Police –Ionia Post, Lake Odessa Police Department, The Barry County Sheriff's Office, R2C Towing.
